
Food for the Mind and the Soul

- * Start with an empty cereal box.
- * Cover or paint the top of the box, being sure the slit and tab work so you can open the box.
- * Make a cover for the book you read. It should be the size of one large surface of the box. Include the name of the book, its author, and your name. Paste it to the box.
- * Write a summary of the plot. Attach it to the other side of the box.
- * Cover both narrow sides. On one side, list the characters in the story. On the other narrow side, describe the setting of the story.
- * On a piece of paper, write the following items:
 - 1. What you liked about the story
 - 2. The Christian message the story has for readers
 - 3. A list of people you think would enjoy reading the story
- * Put the evaluation sheet inside the box for your classmates to read.
